Classes Offered:

IQ: Open to all eligible breeds, non-regular class with no credit toward titles. JE: Open to all eligible breeds. SE: Open only to dogs that have acquired a JE title. ME: Open only to dogs that have acquired a SE title. A dog may be entered in both IQ (Non-regular) and JE (Regular). ME title dogs may enter multiple classes in each event. **Rule change (Sept. 1, 2012): Any Dog May Enter a Junior Class Test.** (Previously dogs that had earned a Junior or Senior title were not allowed to enter a Junior Class Test until they had earned a Master title. Now, any dog may enter a Junior Class test, but no further JE certificates will be issued.)

Pre-entry Fees: IQ (Non-Regular) \$20.00; JE, SE & ME \$22.00. **All entries must be accompanied by entry fees and the release form to be valid.**

Refunds: There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal, except for bitches in heat (see dogs eligible to enter).

“Day-of” entries accepted for IQ, JE, and SE. Gate entries close 30 minutes prior to the start of each event.

Day-of Test Entry Fees (IQ, JE, and SE only): IQ - \$22.00, JE & SE - \$25.00.

Move-Ups accepted until 7:30 AM for Saturday morning event; 11:30 AM for Saturday afternoon Event; and 7:30 AM for Sunday event.

Bitches in season may not be entered. Entry fees will be refunded (except for \$3.50 AKC Fee) for bitches in season with Veterinary certificate or presentation of the bitch to the committee. Request must be made before 7:30 AM on the day of entered test.

Entries may be completed in any of the following 3 methods:

- 1) **Fill out the AKC entry form on-line at www.msdachshund.org, then print it out, sign, and send by surface mail to secretary with check.**
- 2) **Print out the AKC entry form at www.msdachshund.org, fill in and mail to secretary with check.**

NOTE: A separate entry form per entry, per class is required or your entry will not be accepted.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 fee for any returned check.

Awards:

A green rosette offered by MDC shall be awarded to each dog qualifying for JE, SE or ME.

A pale green ribbon offered by MDC shall be awarded to each dog qualifying for IQ.

Any dog completing a title shall be awarded a titling rosette offered by the MDC.

Any dog qualifying in SE & ME in the same event will be awarded an Iron Dog ribbon by the MDC.

IQ: 8:30 AM, Check-in by 8:00 AM.

JE: 9:00 AM or 30 minutes after completion of IQ, Check-in by 8:30 AM.

SE: 11:00 AM or 30 minutes after completion of ME (whichever is earlier).

ME: 8:00 AM, Check-in by 7:30 AM (Brace drawing at 7:30 AM).

Saturday Afternoon, April 16, 2016

IQ: ½ hour after morning judging is complete or 12:30 PM, whichever is earlier. Check-in by 11:30 AM.

JE: ½ hour after morning judging is complete or 12:30 PM, whichever is earlier. Check-in by 11:30 AM.

SE: ½ hour after morning judging is complete or 12:30 PM, whichever is earlier. Check-in by 11:30 AM.

Sunday Morning, April 17, 2016

IQ: 8:30 AM, Check-in by 8:00 AM.

JE: 9:00 AM or 30 minutes after completion of IQ, Check-in by 8:30 AM.

SE: 10:30 AM or 30 minutes after completion of ME (whichever is earlier).

ME: 8:00 AM, Check-in by 7:30 AM (Brace drawing at 7:30 AM).

Orientation for each class will be 15 minutes prior to starting time. Please be mindful of the time, as the judges will stay on schedule.

Check-In and Running Order:

Check-in for all classes begins at 7:30 AM each day, with ME taking precedence. Entrants are requested to check in prior to the start of their class. Entrants not appearing when called will be moved to the end of the order. Dogs will run in the order entries received with consideration given to multiple dogs with the same handler, dogs entered in multiple classes, volunteers and workers.

Dogs entered by the closing date that qualify to enter a test other than the one on their entry form may have their entry changed by contacting the Test Secretary by 7:30 AM on the test day.

*Eligible Breeds: Dachshunds and terrier breeds: Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Glen of Imaal, Smooth Fox, Wire Fox, Parson Russell, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Schnauzer, Norfolk, Norwich, Rat, Russell, Sealyham, Scottish, Silky, Skye, Welsh, West Highland White and Yorkshire. Dogs must be 6 months of age and registered with the AKC or have a PAL/ILP granted by the AKC. A dog of eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Sec. 1 of the Dog Show Rules.

All dogs must be confined or on leash except when judged. No Flexi Leads or pinch collars allowed on site.

Test Site: Thistlerose Farms is a working horse and crop farm, and is the home of Thistlerose Border Terriers. Thistlerose was the childhood home of owner, Shelia Sanders, who now returns from New York. Shelia recalls living in Jackson, MS, as a youngster, when her father announced, “President Roosevelt is about to get us into a war!” and briskly moved his family to the safe haven of Copiah County, MS. There is much history here – an especially blissful sort of place. The site was once the home of Brown’s Wells Health Resort perhaps from around 1850 until the early 1900’s, where the affluent came to play and soak away their cares in Brown’s Wells

Springs. Imagine that time as you walk where they walked, in fields that once served as the Spa's golf course.

Our Test Committee is very proud to have such a wonderful facility available for our test. Please be ever mindful and respectful of the property by picking up after yourself and your dog(s), and driving and parking only in designated areas. We desire to maintain high credibility with Thistlerose so that AKC events such as this will continue to be welcome. Trash barrels will be available for your use. A release will be provided for your signature upon arrival.

Food: Complimentary coffee and doughnuts will be available each morning. For a small donation, coffee, water, and cold drinks will be available throughout both days and lunch will be available on Saturday Noon. No lunch available on Sunday. There are several fast food restaurants in Hazelhurst, MS (within 10 mi. of the test site) and numerous restaurants in Brookhaven, MS, (within 17 mi. of the test site).

RV Parking: Self-contained RV overnight parking is available on site for a fee of \$10/per night. No reservations required. Everyone parking over night must sign a release form that will be provided at registration. RVs will be allowed on Thistlerose Farms after 8:00 AM on Friday, April 15, 2014, and must leave Sunday, April 27, 2014, within an hour after completion of the AKC earthdog test. RVs must be self-contained. No electric or water hook-ups and no dumping on site. Nearest dump station is available at nearby Lake Lincoln State Park (10 mi), 2573 Sunset Road North East, Wesson, MS 39191, (601) 643-9044. No tent camping is permitted on the Thistlerose site.

Directions to Test Site:

From I-55 North: From I-55 at Hazelhurst, MS, take Exit 61 onto Highway 28 West. Go West toward Natchez for 6 miles. Turn left on Browns Wells Rd. Travel 2-1/2 miles to Thistlerose Farms, 4045 Brown's Wells Road, Wesson, MS, on the right.

From I-55 South: Take Exit 51, Wesson, MS. Head West on Sylvarena Road for 2.2 miles. Turn **RIGHT** onto Brownsells Road (North). Continue for 4.0 miles to Thistlerose Farms on the **Left**, 4045 Brown's Wells Road, Wesson, MS. [Destination is .3 miles past Cain Road. If you reach Tyson Road, you have gone too far.]
